A select group of Nevada State Park Staff will judge entries. Judging criteria will include:

One winner will be selected from two categories. Each winner will receive an annual Nevada State Parks Day Pass (valued at \$75).

Category 1 - Kindergarten thru 5th grade

Category 2 - 6th grade thru 12th grade
