



What is SafeVoice?

SafeVoice is an anonymous tip system used to report threats to the safety or well-being of students. SafeVoice is a digital tool that empowers students to report any situation that may put their friends, themselves or their school at risk and remain anonymous. The program, run by the Nevada Department of Education and Department of Public Safety, follows up on every report to make certain appropriate steps have been taken to ensure the safety of your child. SafeVoice assigns a team of professionals, made up of counselors, administrators and law enforcement, to every tip received. Teams are trained to process the report and take action to intervene.
